#### **Swift Watching this Summer!**

In these troubled times the return of the Swifts will bring especial joy, with perhaps also a little envy of their careless freedom as they wheel over our streets and countryside. Whilst we humans remain in lockdown, I have a suggestion for a pleasurable birding activity, which you can incorporate into your local exercise walk, and stay safe and within the law as well. It's simply this. Look out for your local Swifts.

They arrive in early May and quite possibly there will be some near you. If you see any flying low over roof tops, possibly making screaming calls as they pass, please note where they are. No other British bird behaves like this. It's an indication there are nest sites nearby. You might even be lucky enough to spot one returning to its nest hole under the eaves of a building.

So why are we interested? Well, the population of Swifts is more than 50% lower than it was 25 years ago. They need our help. Having these records can help Swift conservation by increasing our knowledge of local populations, enabling us to protect a nest site or lobbying for new ones.

Having spent their entire life on the wing and flown 1000's of miles, sometimes they can end up on the ground squeaking. Generally once on the floor they can't get airborne again. **RSPB advice:** If you find a grounded swift, check that there are no obvious injuries, that the breast is not sharp and thin (starving) and that any flight feathers are not still sheathing (young bird). If the bird is not injured, take it to an upstairs window, (for an adult bird an outstretched arm when standing up may be adequate). Place the bird on the palm of your hand, head facing outwards/away from you. Gently raise and lower your arm, thus allowing the bird to feel the air under its wings. It should then start taking an interest and usually takes off with confidence.

#### **Donations required for Bicester Food Bank**

The Akeman Benefice has made a plea to all parishes in the benefice for donations to the Bicester Food Bank. Items that are needed include: tinned goods (mainly tomatoes, peas, carrots and sweetcorn), packets of savoury and sweet biscuits, tinned fish and long-life milk. They do <u>not</u> require pasta, pasta sauces, tea or pulses.

Even a small amount given regularly by standing order enables them to get the things that are needed, and to pay the rent for their town centre location.

If anyone in Chesterton is willing to donate food items, please put them inside the porch of St Mary's Church (even though the church is locked, the porch is open) any time up to and including <u>Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> May</u>, after which they will be collected and delivered to the Food Bank by a volunteer.
